CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL

1. Proof of application of water to beneficial use shall be submitted on or before **February 01, 2015**.
2. Subject to all prior water rights.
3. This right does not grant any right-of-way or easement across the land of another.
4. Domestic use is for 4 homes. Irrigation of lawn, garden and landscaping associated with the home is authorized under the irrigation component of this right.
5. Project construction shall commence within one year from the date of permit issuance and shall proceed diligently to completion unless it can be shown to the satisfaction of the Director of the Department of Water Resources that delays were due to circumstances over which the permit holder had no control.
6. Right holder shall comply with the drilling permit requirements of Section 42-235, Idaho Code and applicable Well Construction Rules of the Department.
7. This right when combined with all other rights shall provide no more than 0.03 cfs per acre nor more than 3.0 afa per acre at the field headgate for irrigation of the lands above.

This permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of Section 42-204, Idaho Code. Witness the signature of the Director, affixed at Coeur d'Alene, this 22nd day of January, 2010.
